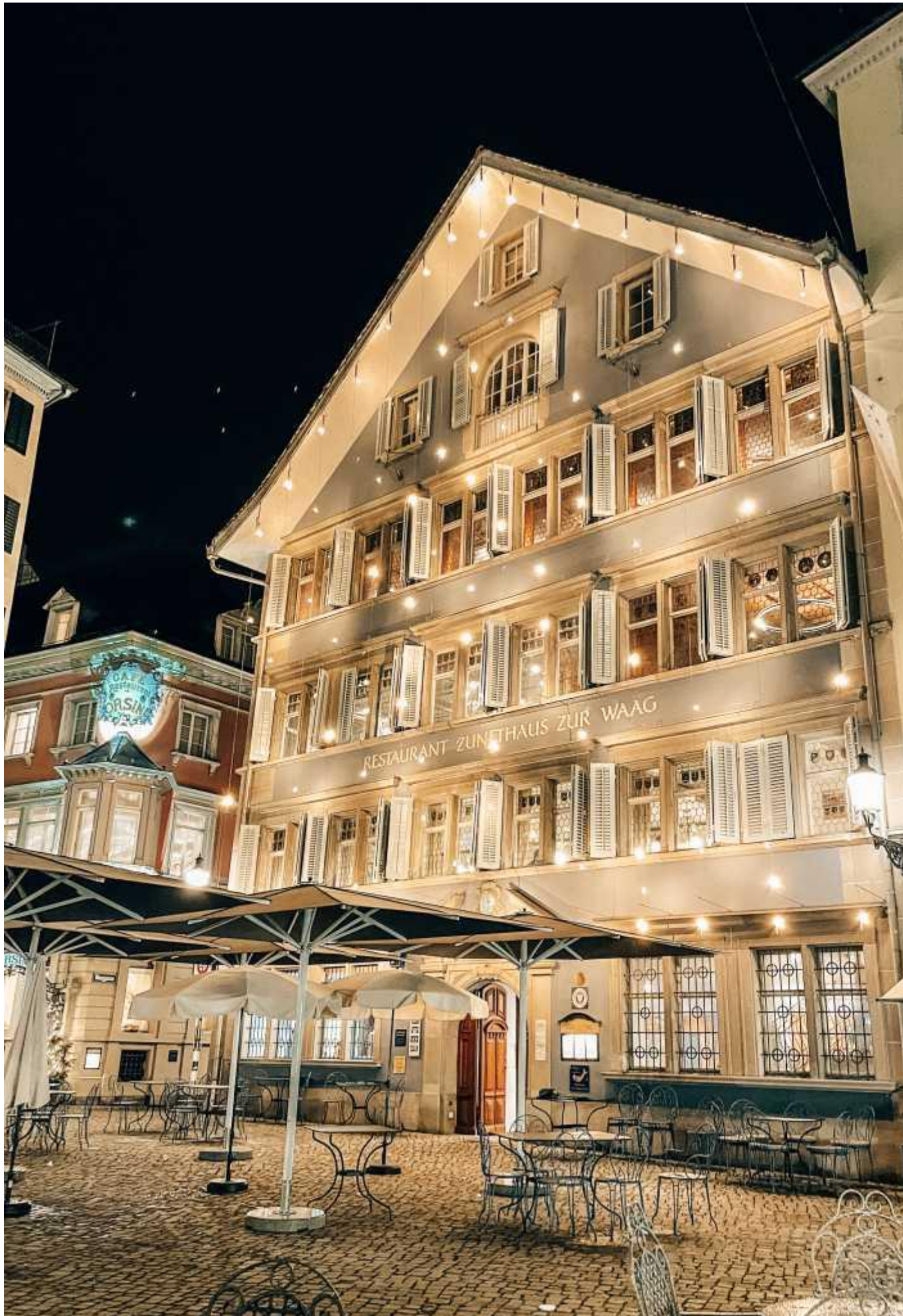


## **ZunftHaus zur Waag**

For authentic Swiss cuisine, impeccable service, and a fine selection of wines, the 17th century ZunftHaus zur Waag is one of the best historic restaurant venues for local visitors and international celebrities alike who visit Zurich.



Zurich's guilds had an important influence in city's history since the 14th century. These guilds, or *zünfte* used to be prestigious men's clubs, where the city's elites would gather to meet and discuss trade matters.

One such guild-house is the Zunfthaus zur Waag. Established in 1303, it was the guild of Zurich's linen weavers. Today, it is one of Zurich's top restaurant establishments serving traditional, refined Swiss cuisine. It also has a few large halls which are excellent choices for wedding receptions, anniversary events and corporate functions of up to 150 guests.

Both the interior restaurant setting and its exteriors were nothing short of elegant. The restaurant's light blue facade, with its breathtaking Chagall windows were lit up with Christmas lightings, and it was a glittering sight to behold on the Münsterhof. Inside the restaurant, we were comfortably seated amongst 10 or so tables intimately set up with crisp white linens, fresh exotic flowers and rich red carpet and upholstery.

Highly recommended Swiss fares here include the Zürcher Geschnietzelte and the Wiener Schnitzel, paired beautifully with a glass of local pinot. Remember to save room for the chocolate mousse (made with the restaurant's secret recipe), with texture as light as a cloud!
